Think Big Developments provides work experience and apprenticeships to young adults from all backgrounds between the ages of 16-24. Their ethos is to recruit on attitude and not academic performance. As an organisation they believe that everyone deserves an opportunity and should never be discriminated against.

The organisation required some form of finance to be able to invest in the necessary equipment to provide their valuable service within the local community. There was also a general lack of knowledge around what support was available which would enable the business to grow.
